

HOME SAFETY CHECKLIST

Keep your family safe from potential hazards at home by checking your household for the following safety items and features regularly.



- Smoke detectors**
Install fresh batteries and test each detector!
- Carbon monoxide detectors**
Install fresh batteries and test each detector!
- Fire extinguishers**
Confirm the pressure gauge or indicator is in the operable range or position, and lift the extinguisher to ensure it is still full.
- Fully stocked first aid kit**
- Flashlights**
Check the batteries!
- Annual maintenance/service tag on furnace/boiler**
- Documentation of annual chimney inspection and cleaning**
- Sump pump**
Test it to make sure it's operating properly!
- Electric panels with proper covers**
- Safe use of electrical outlets**
No overcrowding. If you do find outlets that are overcrowded, try using a power strip with a circuit breaker.
- Safe and secure hand railings for all stairs**
- Warning sign if you have a dog at home**
- Driveway and walkway level and free of any trip hazards**
- Decks and porches secured to house and free of rot**
- Deck rails are secure, balusters are present and no more than 4 inches apart**
- Well secured gutters free of any debris**
- Properly trimmed trees with no limbs overhanging the roof**
- Fencing around your pool or other body of water (if applicable)**
